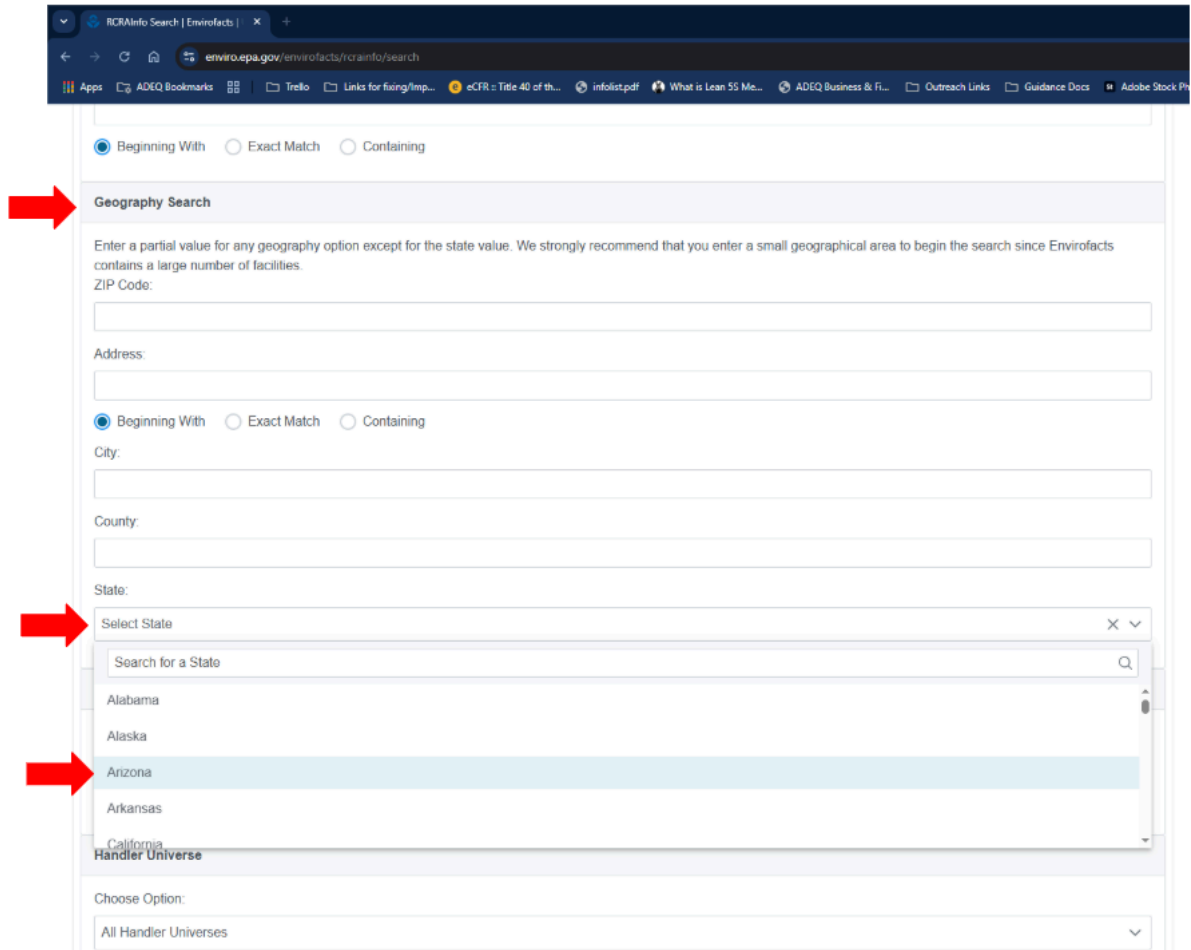
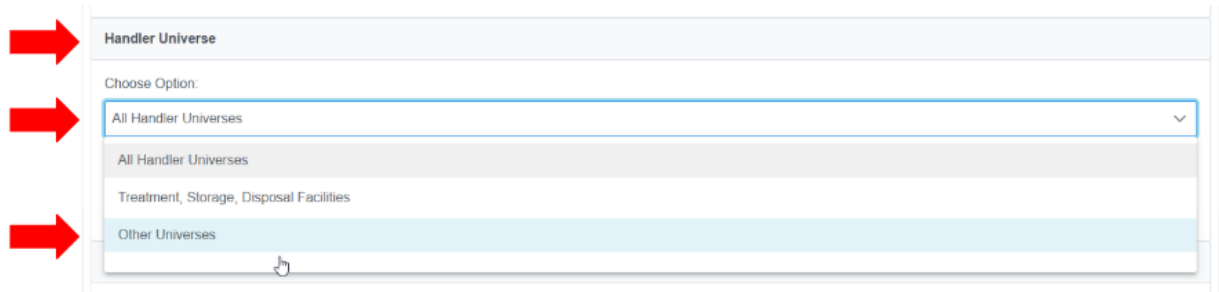


Finding a Transporter Using RCRAInfo Search

1. Navigate to <https://enviro.epa.gov/envirofacts/rcrainfo/search>
2. Scroll down to the **Geography Search** section and select **Arizona** from the **Select State** dropdown menu



3. Scroll down to the **Handler Universe** section and choose **Other Universes** in the **All Handler Universes** dropdown menu



4. Then choose **Transporter** in the **Subject to Corrective Action** dropdown menu
