

Summary of House Bill 2367



- Eliminates one-time rulemaking authorities
- Authorizes moving fee on new tire sales and landfill disposal fees to rule
- Authorizes rulemakings to establish new fees for services already being performed
- Removes duplicative Joint Legislative Budget Committee review requirement language


- Solid waste management including generation, shipping, treatment, & disposal
- Use of Best Management Practices & Self Certification
- Management of used oil including generation, shipping, processors, refiners, & burners
- Biohazardous medical waste transporters, storage, & disposal
 - Management of used and waste tires
 - Management of septage haulers
- Management of Special Waste generators, shippers, & disposal
 - Solid waste composting
 - Recycling of lead acid batteries
 - Solid waste recycling
 - Management of Advanced Recycling Facilities
 - (Coming Soon) Coal Combustion Residuals

Loss of funding from the General Fund begins fee-for-service model in 2012






48.52% since 2012 for Phx Urban Area

 Moving A.R.S. 49-836 tonnage fee to rule and increase by CPI (See next slide)

Landfills – Revise Tiered Fees

- Small (<60K Tons/Yr)
 - \$5,000 annually
- Medium (>60K but <225K Tons/Yr)
 - \$10,000 annually
- Large (>225 Tons/Yr)
 - \$20,000 annually
- Approved for Post Closure (New)
 - \$3,500 annually
- Plan Review per A.R.S. 49-762 &
 A.A.C. R18-13-702 (See next slide)



Transfer Facilities

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Self Cert (>180 CY per day)
 - Initial \$3,600
 - Annual \$3,000 per year
- BMP (<180 CY per day)
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year
- Self Cert increase in fees
- BMP all new fees

Those impacted...Tire Management






 Moving A.R.S. 44-1302 fee on new tires to rule and increase by CPI = \$2.00 cap to \$4.66 cap

Tire Management

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Plan Approval Tire Sites (>12mo)
 - \$5,000 annually + Plan Review Fee
- Self Cert Waste Tires (>5,000)
- Tire Shredder/ Processor
 - Initial \$3,600
 - Annual \$3,000 per year
- BMP Waste Tires (>500 but <5000)
 - Initial \$2,400
 - Annual \$2,000 per year
- Used Tires (>100)
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year

Those impacted...Used Oil Management





Used Oil Management

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Transporters per 40 CFR § 279.42
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year
- Processor per 40 CFR § 279.51
 - Initial \$9,000
 - Annual \$7,500 per year
- Burner per 40 CFR § 279.62
 - Initial \$15,000
 - Annual \$12,500 per year
- Marketer per 40 CFR § 279.73
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year

Biohazardous Medical Waste

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Transporters
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year
- Storage/Transfer
 - Annual \$7,500 per year
 - + Plan Review Fee
- Treatment/Disposal
 - Annual \$12,500 per year
 - + Plan Review Fee
- Plan Review per A.R.S. 49-762

Those impacted...Special Waste Management





 A.R.S. 49-855 and increase by CPI from \$4.50 per ton to \$6.68 per ton & increases cap from \$45,000 per site to \$66,835 per site

Special Waste Management

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Generators-PCS
 - Initial \$900
 - Annual \$750 per year
- Generators-ASF
 - Initial \$3600
 - Annual \$3000 per year
- Transporters
 - Initial \$1,800
 - Annual \$1,500 per year
- Treatment/Disposal
 - Annual \$5,000 per year + Plan
 Review Fee

Those impacted...Septage Haulers





Septage Haulers

- Registration Initial/Annual
- Fee per hauler inspected by County
 - Initial \$270
 - Annual \$225
- Fee per hauler inspected by ADEQ
 - Initial \$660
 - Annual \$550




Lead Acid Battery Recyclers

- Pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-1322
- Registration Initial/Annual
 - Initial \$810
 - Annual \$675 per year

 - Annual \$5,000 per year
- Plan Review per A.R.S. 49-762
