



Septage Hauler Instructions for Registration

This document will help you understand the process involved in obtaining an ADEQ Septage Hauler License number for a new vehicle, or have your septage hauling vehicle inspected annually as required by [R18-13-1103. General Requirements; License Fees.](#)

Delegated Authority to Arizona Counties

Per Arizona Revised Statutes ([A.R.S.](#) 49-107 (A)) the ADEQ Director may choose to delegate public health services, such as septage hauler inspections, to a local county health department. In the State of Arizona, all counties except Yavapai County, have been delegated the authority to conduct inspections for septage hauler vehicles.

Each county has a slightly different process for the licensing inspections for septage haulers, but in general the process for obtaining an ADEQ Septic License Hauler Number is as follows:

- 1) Access and download the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Solid Waste Unit (SWU) [SEPTAGE HAULER LICENSE APPLICATION](#) and fill out sections 1 through 7 on the first page of the application.
- 2) Contact your local authority using the information provided below, and schedule a place and time to conduct the Septage Hauler Inspection. Bring your filled out septage hauler application to the inspection (from step 1). The local authority may use the ADEQ form or provide their own form, depending on the county.
- 3) Once your inspection is complete, and your vehicle has been approved by the local authority, submit your completed ADEQ Septage Hauler License Application, appropriate fees, and an approved septic hauler inspection to Solidwaste@azdeq.gov (or mail to the address listed on the ADEQ Septage Hauler License Application) to receive an approval/denial of an ADEQ License Hauler Number.
