

## Notice of Site Listing Activities and 30-Day Comment Period

51st Avenue and Camelback Road  
Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund Site

On August 18, 2021, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) placed the 51st Avenue and Camelback Road site (Site) on the Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund Registry.<sup>1</sup>

The Site contains contaminated groundwater in Glendale and Phoenix, Maricopa County, Arizona. The Site contaminant(s) of concern COCs are tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), and 1,1-dichloroethene (1,1-DCE). Approximate Site boundaries are West Bethany Home to the north, West Indian School Road to the south, North 43rd Avenue to the east, and North 59th Avenue to the west. The boundaries estimate the geographic extent of known contamination and may change as new information becomes available.

The Site Eligibility & Evaluation score is 29 out of 120. The score is based on available information regarding the presence of hazardous substances at the Site. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health, welfare, or the environment.

Other Site Listing activities include:<sup>2</sup>

- ADEQ developed the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) scope of work. Any person, by agreement with the department, may develop and implement the RI/FS work plan;<sup>3</sup> to do so, contact Gianna Trujillo at [Trujillo.Gianna@azdeq.gov](mailto:Trujillo.Gianna@azdeq.gov).
- ADEQ created a fact sheet and Community Involvement Plan (CIP) outline.
