

Notice of 60-day Public Comment Period

Draft Remedial Investigation Report
Remedial Objectives Solicitation
Bahama Avenue and Bimini Lane
Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund Site

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) released the draft Remedial Investigation (RI) report for the Bahama Avenue and Bimini Lane Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund site (Site) in Lake Havasu City, AZ (Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(c)(1)(b)). The Remedial Investigation identifies the nature, extent and source(s) of the Site's contamination; current and potential impacts to public health and the environment; current and reasonably foreseeable land and water uses at the Site; and evaluates other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions.

The Site contains contaminated groundwater and soil. The Site contaminants of concern are tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), and arsenic. Approximate Site boundaries are Industrial Boulevard to the north, El Camino Drive to the south, the Orion Lane alignment to the east, and Lake Havasu to the west in Lake Havasu City.

ADEQ will hold a public meeting for interested parties to comment on the draft RI report and provide input on the Site's remedial objectives. Remedial objectives are the Site clean-up goals and consider the current and reasonably foreseeable future uses of land and waters at the Site. **The meeting date** is Tuesday, September 1, 2026. The meeting will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at the Lake Havasu City Council Chambers, Lake Havasu Municipal Court, 2nd Floor, 92 Acoma Blvd South, Lake Havasu City, AZ.
