






## Site Detail Map

- Unknown Source of Contamination
- Current Impacted Media = Groundwater
- Potential Receptors = Salt River Project water supply well (17.9E-7.5N)

# Groundwater Remediation Summary/Update




- Currently performing semi-annual groundwater monitoring
- Long and diffuse plume
- PCE Concentrations above Arizona Aquifer Water Quality Standard (AWQS) of 5 micrograms per Liter (μg/L) in March 2024 ranged from 5.6 to 140 μg/L
- PCE concentrations are decreasing or remaining stable in most monitoring wells

# Groundwater Plume Map









Groundwater Depth approximately 45 feet in NW to 90 feet in SW


#### **Groundwater Concentration Trend**
