

Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) Site Community Informational Meeting Miller Valley Road and Hillside Avenue

The Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) program, also called State Superfund, supports ADEQ in identifying, prioritizing, assessing and resolving the threat of contaminated soil and groundwater sites in the state. The program conducts statewide efforts using state funds and oversees privately funded cleanups as well. In 2016, Miller Valley Road and Hillside Avenue was added to the list of sites that may pose a risk to public health or the environment, called the WQARF Registry, due to contaminants detected in the groundwater at the site.
