Feasibility Study
40th Street and Osborn Road
Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund Site

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) completed the Feasibility Study for the 40th Street and Osborn Road Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund site (Site) in Phoenix, AZ¹. The Feasibility Study identifies a reference remedy and alternative remedies that should achieve the Site's remedial objectives. It evaluates them based on comparison criteria to select a remedy that complies with A.R.S. § 49-282.06².

The Site contains contaminated groundwater in Phoenix, AZ. The approximate Site boundaries are East Fairmont Avenue to the north, East Hubbell Street to the south, 42nd to the east and 25th Street to the west. The Site contaminant of concern is tetrachloroethene (PCE).
