

Notice of 30-Day Comment Period:

Remedial Action Approval and Cost Credit
Park-Euclid Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund Site

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has received two requests from the Park-Euclid Group (Group) related to the Park-Euclid Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund site (Site) in Tucson, AZ:

- 1) Approval of past remedial actions (A.A.C. R18-16-413)
- 2) A cost credit for implemented remedial actions (A.A.C. R18-16-409(H))

The Site contains contaminated groundwater and soil vapor plumes. The approximate Site boundaries are 9th Street to the north, 14th Street to the south, Mountain Avenue to the east, and Euclid Avenue to the west in Tucson. The Site contaminants of concern are tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), *cis*-1,2-dichloroethene (*cis*-1,2-DCE), *trans*-1,2-dichloroethene (*trans*-1,2-DCE), and vinyl chloride.
