

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
STONE AVENUE AND GRANT ROAD
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
RECORD OF DECISION (ROD)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has issued a record of decision (ROD), which is deemed a final administrative decision as defined by Arizona Revised Statutes §49-287.04 for the Stone Avenue and Grant Road Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Tucson, Arizona. The ROD contains a description of the remedy, a responsiveness summary regarding all comments received on the proposed remedial action plan, a time for completing the remedy, a total estimated cost, and a time frame for review.

The Stone Avenue and Grant Road WQARF site consists of two areas of soil contamination above the residential Soil Remediation Levels (SRL) for tetrachloroethene (PCE) of 0.51 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg). The extent of soil contamination is limited to two properties located on the southeast and northwest corners of the North Stone Avenue and West Grant Road intersection.
