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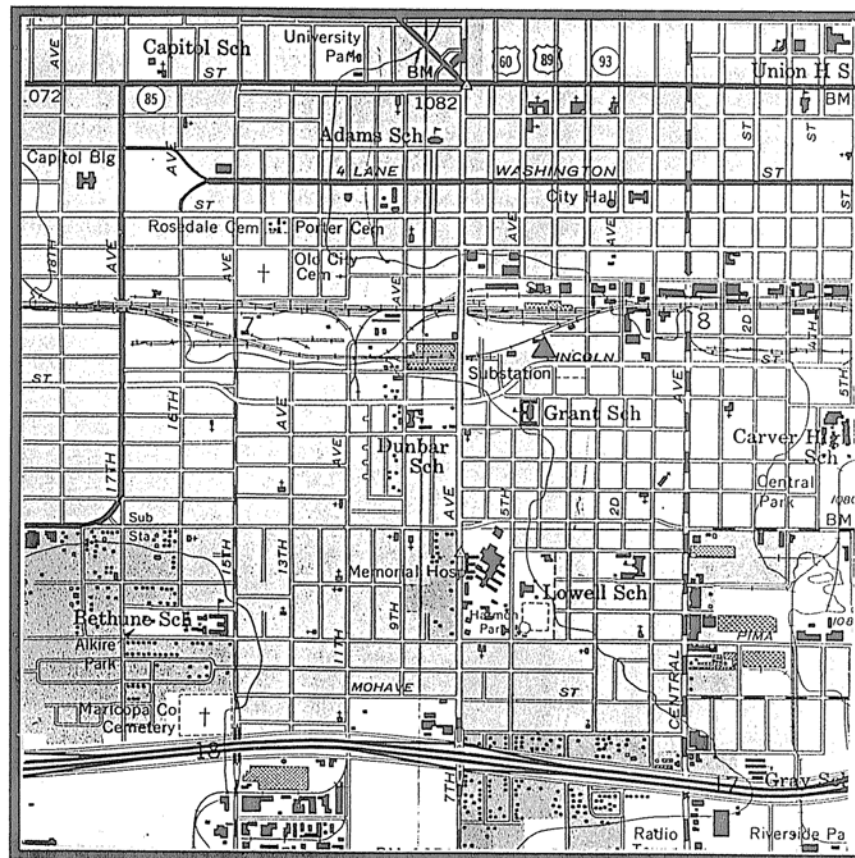

Figure C-1 Site location map of the 320 West Lincoln Street property in Phoenix, Arizona.

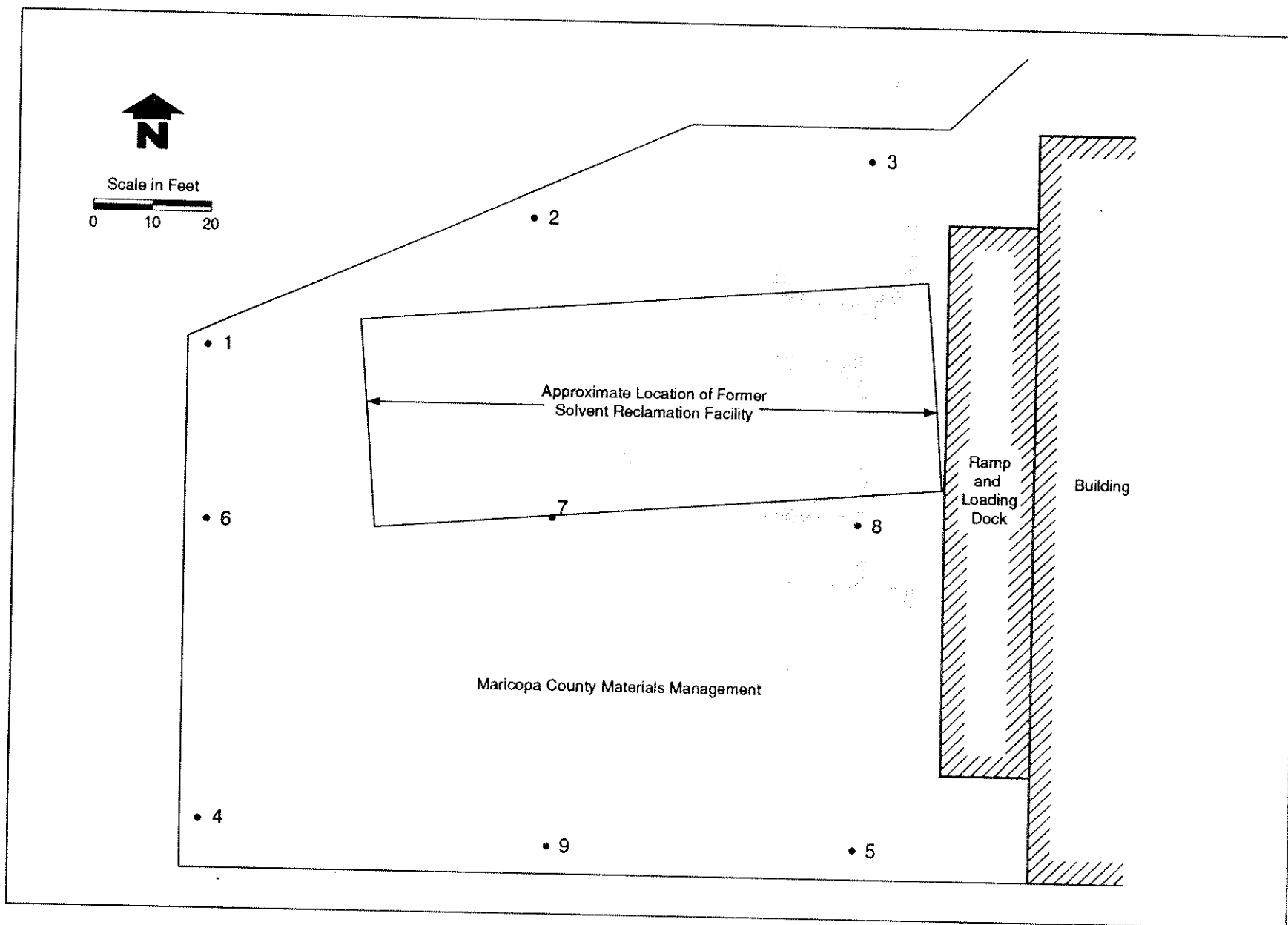


Figure C-2 Maricopa County Materials Management soil gas sampling locations 17-19 June 1992.

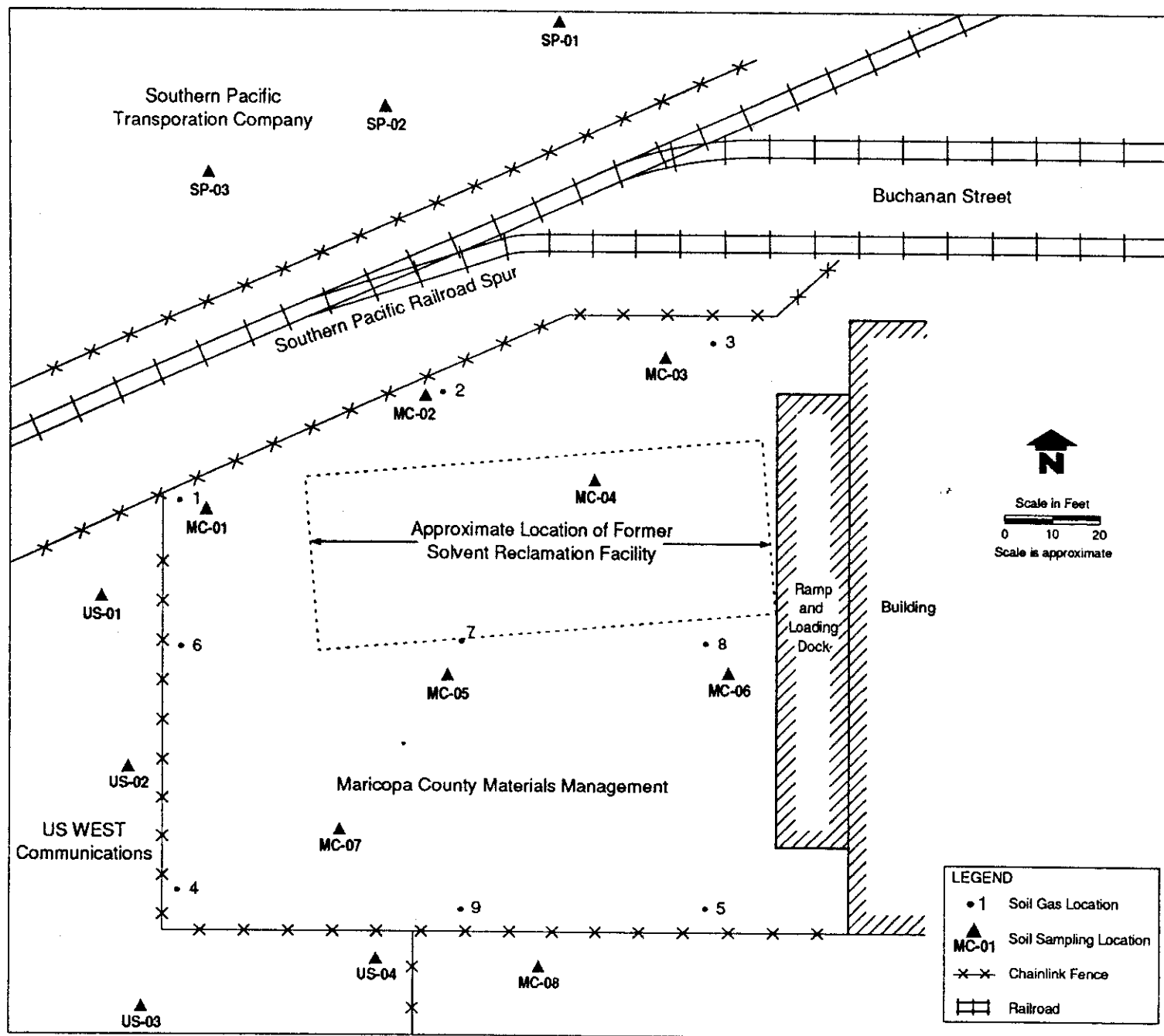


Figure C-3 Soil Sampling Locations, 18-20 February 1993.

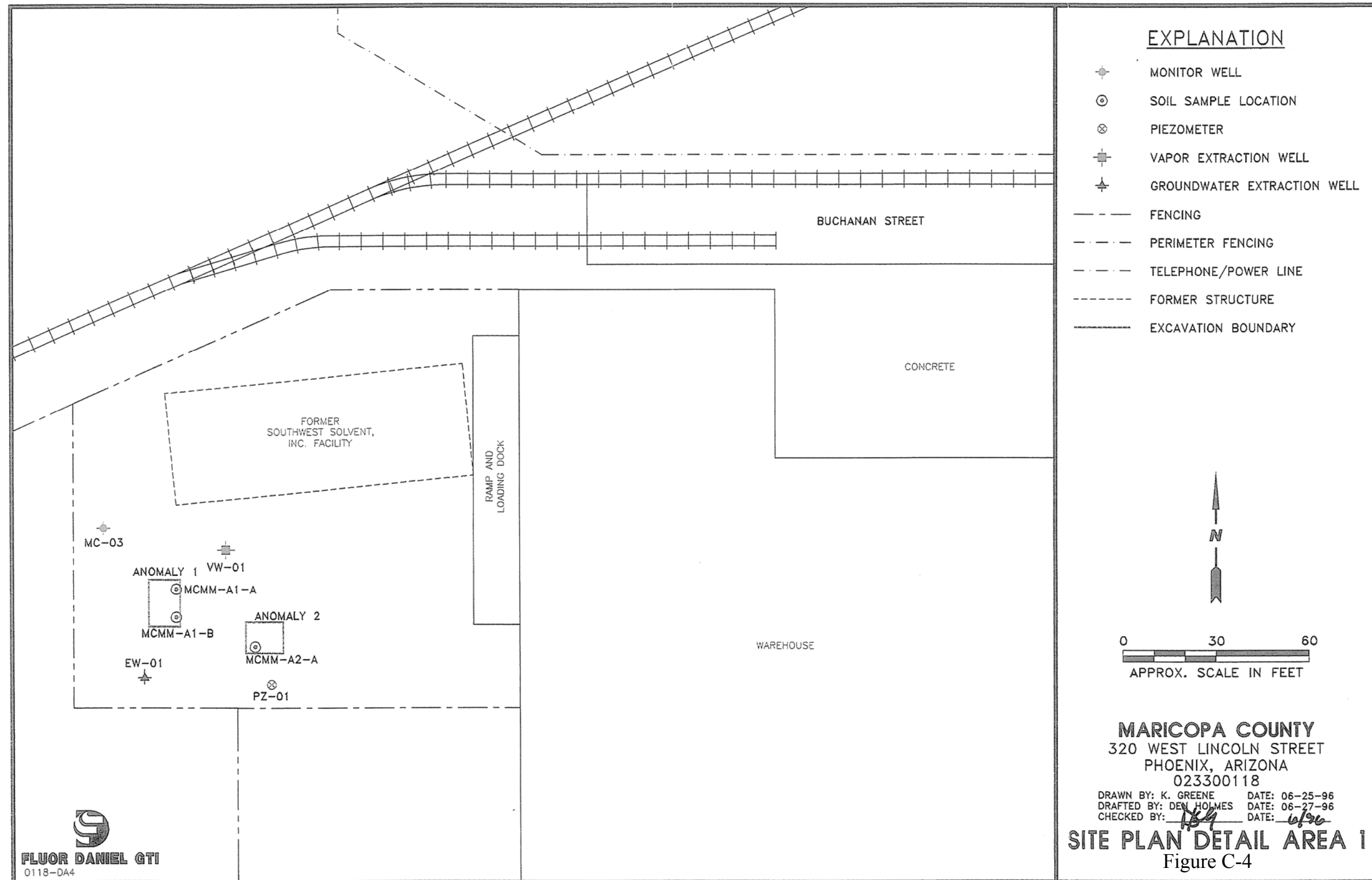
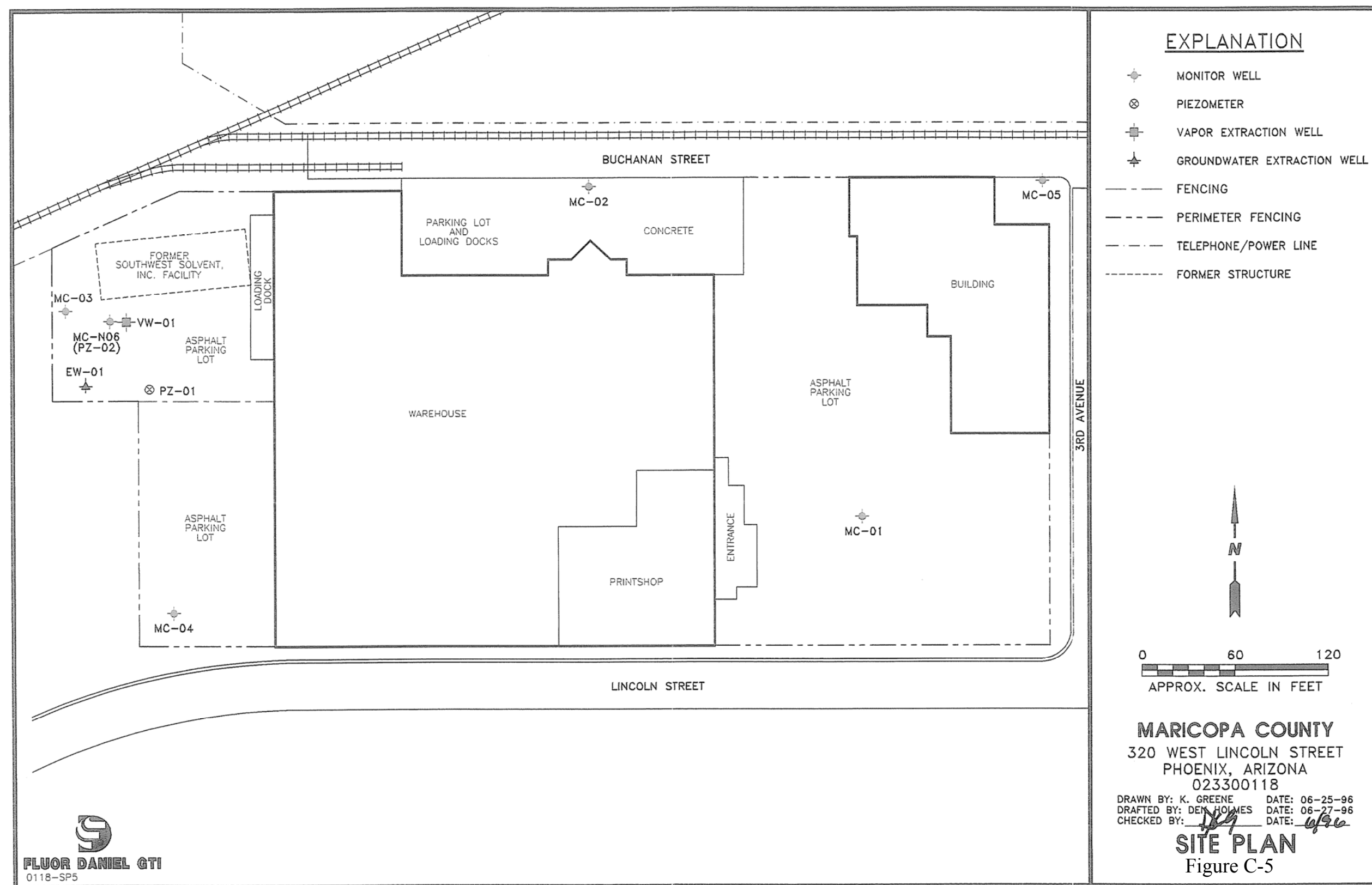


Figure C-4: Site Plan Detail Area 1 showing June 27, 1995 anomaly excavations and soil sample locations at 320 West Lincoln Street.



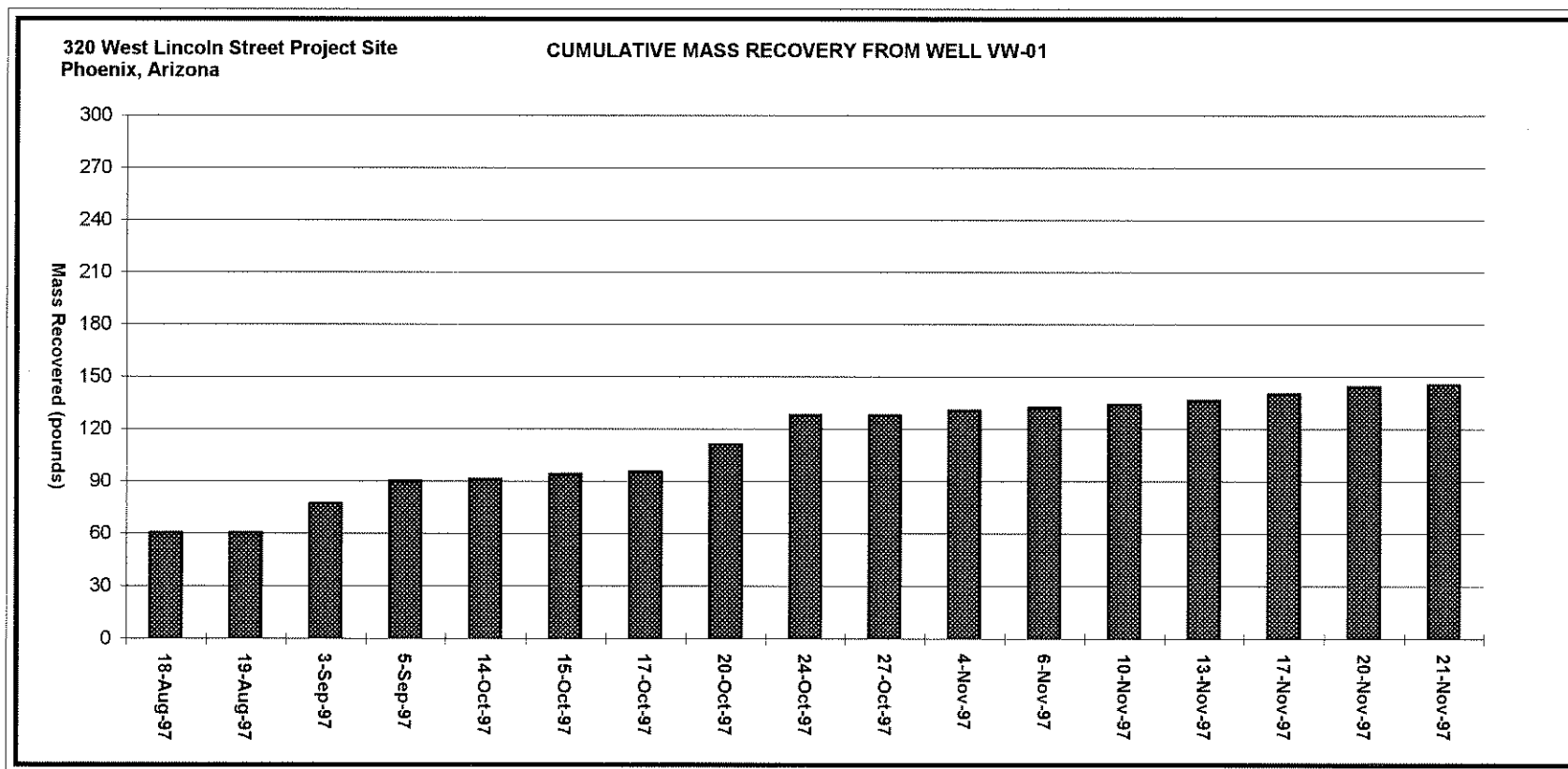


Figure C-6 Cumulative Mass Recovery From Well VW-01
