

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

The SLE Utility Company PWS # 14075 Has Levels of Uranium Above Drinking Water Standards

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation.

We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Testing results we received over the past twelve months show that our system has exceeded the standard or maximum contaminant level (MCL), for Uranium. The standard for uranium is 30 micro grams/liter or less. The average level of uranium last year has been in excess of that standard, approximately 32.5 micro grams/liter.

What should I do?

You are encouraged to use the alternate source (e.g. bottled) drinking water supply that has been installed at the club house. There is no charge for this water, and you can use what you need. This is for **drinking water only**. You may continue to use the water that is supplied to your home for other uses (laundry, bathing etc.) However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

What does this mean?

This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However, some people who drink water containing uranium in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer and kidney toxicity.

What is being done?

Steps have been taken to develop a plan within the next 180 days to resolve this issue.
