

PUBLIC NOTICE
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Wenden D.W.I.D Water System has levels of "Arsenic" above drinking water standards

Our water system violated a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Testing results we received for the 4th Quarter 2017 compliance period show that our system is below the contaminant level (MCL), for arsenic. The running annual average (RAA) still exceeds the MCL. The standard is 0.01 mg/L. The 4th Quarter sample was taken October 11, 2017 with a result of 0.0095.

What should I do?

- **You do not need to use an alternative (e.g., bottled) water supply.** However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

What does this mean?

- This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However, some people who drink water containing arsenic in excess of the MCL over many years could experience skin damage or problems with their circulatory system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What is being done?

- We are working with Arizona Department of Environmental Services to evaluate the water supply and are researching options to correct the problem. These options may include treating the water to remove arsenic or connect to another systems water supply.
