



# What is MAP sampling for this year at my system?

A guide to using the new AZ Safe Drinking Water  
Information System tool

- Go to the Arizona Safe Drinking Water Information System (SDWIS) website:  
[https://azsdwis.azdeq.gov/DWW\\_EXT/](https://azsdwis.azdeq.gov/DWW_EXT/)

- Enter the last 5 digits of your Public Water System (PWS) ID number (usually starts with AZ04XXXX) and hit the 'Search for Water System' button.

# Step 4

- Once in the main page for your system, hover over the **Schedules** topic and click on *'Samples Due This Year'* from the drop down list.

# Step 5

- Scroll down to the box labeled ***Samples Due This Year***. This will list all of the samples that ADEQ has listed as being due by the end of the year, or quarter.
- This list will exclude the monthly RTCR samples, as well as monthly Residual Chlorine (MDRL) samples, if applicable.

- If you type in Yes in the text box above the ‘*On MAP Schedule*’ column, the list will automatically filter to the samples MAP will be taking this year for your system.
  - If you do not like this view, you can click the ‘**Export to Excel**’ button and the list will be exported to an Excel spreadsheet, which you can then filter and manipulate, as you need.
