

# Searching Arizona TMDLs Using EPA's *How's My Waterway* Application

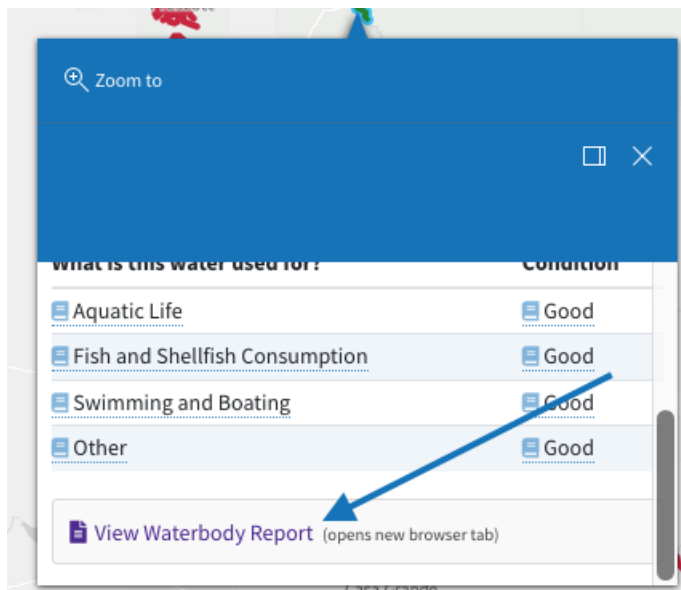
## STEP 1

Visit [mywaterway.epa.gov/state/AZ/advanced-search](https://mywaterway.epa.gov/state/AZ/advanced-search), check the box beside “Has TMDL” under “Additional Filters” and click the Search button.
