Perennial and Intermittent Tributaries and Certain Wetlands






Ephemeral Tributaries and Wetlands with a Significant Nexus

### NAVIGABLE WATERS PROTECTION RULE








### SURFACE WATER PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR ARIZONA








